Monitoring availability of essential medicines

What is a stock out?

...there is physically no stock available at the facility where it is needed and patients leave without treatment in hand.





Why are stock outs a problem?

- Impacts continuity of care and adherence
- Increases patient out-of-pocket spending
- Long term effect on morbidity and mortality
- Patients lose faith in the system, negatively impacting health seeking behaviour
- Additional unnecessary stressor for HCWs
- Negatively impacts quality of care provided
- Planning and ordering at facilities impacted
- Unreliable usage indicators impacts forecasting




Who is reporting stock outs?




What medication is reported?




ARVs reported (by API)




Which provinces are reporting?




What is causing the stock outs?






What does the SSP do with this info?


- Facility contacted for verification & report is logged
- All reports are escalated
- Only vital items are case managed
- Standard case management protocol followed
- Constant feedback where possible

Some key challenges:

- Quality of information received from reporting individuals
- Unable to reach facilities for verification of reports
- Lack of feedback once reports are escalated
- Negative impact on relationships with management if HCW is identified as having reported stock outs
